■ The City of Florence identified a significant need for a new fire station to serve the southern part of the city. To meet this need, the city made the decision to construct and operate Fire Station #5 to be located on a nearly 1-acre lot fronting Redbud Lane near the intersection of Howe Springs Road.

■ The design-build facility includes:

- Two drive-thru apparatus bays
- Day room with kitchen/dining area
- Administrative office, exercise and training rooms
- Sleeping facilities with restroom and shower facilities
- Laundry/decontamination room
- Shop, equipment and it/radio storage areas
- Plymovent exhaust removal system
- Natural gas emergency generator

■ This non-LEED project utilized a variety of energy-related strategies including the following:

- Energy-efficient lighting with motion sensors
- Low-flow plumbing fixtures with motion sensors
- Daylighting
- High SEER rated HVAC equipment with energy recovery ventilator
- Recycled content materials and regional materials
